NOMINATIONS:

- 1. Each District Chairman is responsible for the soliciting/completion of nominations and fee from the respective District.
- 2. Review the nomination(s) for accuracy and forwarding to the Lions Headquarters.
- 3. Qualifying nominations will be reviewed for guideline compliance, by the Hall of Fame Committee, and selections approved. Only 2 nominations may be sent in by each District.
- 4. Each nomination with a \$150.00 fee must be submitted in accordance with the guidelines criteria attached.
- 5. The fee will be used to provide a Lions Hall of Fame lapel pin, a plaque engraved with the name. The program is to be maintained from the application fee.
