Each recipient will receive a Lions hall of Fame lapel pin, a plaque, and name permanently engraved on a wall plaque. The wall plaque will be displayed at the Lions State Headquarters Building.

NOMINATIONS:

1. Each District Chairman is responsible for the soliciting/completion of nominations and fee from the respective District.
2. Review the nomination(s) for accuracy and forwarding to the Lions Headquarters.
3. Qualifying nominations will be reviewed for guideline compliance, by the Hall of Fame Committee, and selections approved. Only 2 nominations may be sent in by each District.
4. Each nomination with a \$150.00 fee must be submitted in accordance with the guidelines criteria attached.
5. The fee will be used to provide a Lions Hall of Fame lapel pin, a plaque engraved with the name. The program is to be maintained from the application fee.
